'Go Fish' - different colours link to different questions



Creating stories - write a script & YP can illustrate

Jenga - wooden blocks with conversation starters written on Making a playlist of music

Jigsaw - for any theme/topic

Yoga

2 Truths + 1 Lie

Making dice

Board game - adapt snakes & ladders -+ strengths cards (build self-esteem)

Bag of fidget toys: great for all ages

Beach ball - different perspectives

Boardgames: facilitates conversations 'See', 'think', 'wonder' questions

Learning a Mindful activity

Use an elastic-band to

Drawing: to explore school/family experience

feelings/thoughts/memories

Working with stones to explore aspects of self & relationships

Building upon age appropriate games describe resilience

Cartooning

Playing games with balls:

football, basketball, etc.

A song - breaking the sentences down & exploring the connection to the individual words...

Role play being the teacher in the classroom - so the child has something to do & feel valued

Using waterpaints or markers

Working with natural materials: i.e. wool

Maing a photo-book/PP of a trip out together
